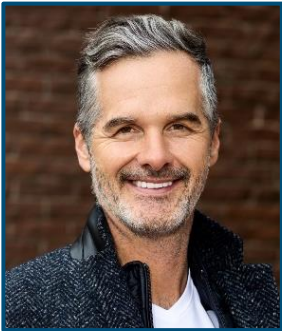

Jodi Hall is the CEO for the Canadian Association for Long Term Care (CALTC). Previously, she served as Executive Director of the New Brunswick Association of Nursing Homes, President of the New Brunswick Continuing Care Safety Association and Co-Chair of the Collaborative for Healthy Aging and Care which works to create a shared conversation among stakeholders on the aging experience in New Brunswick. Jodi also previously served in a range of leadership positions, including as Administrator of a Long Term Care home in New Brunswick. In addition to her work in Atlantic Canada, Jodi was no stranger to CALTC prior to starting in the CEO position, as she served as CALTC's Chairperson for two years.

Martin has accompanied tens of thousands of individuals and hundreds of world-class organizations to maximize their potential and their business development. Dr. McGilton's research program integrates research, practice and policy in long-term care and rehabilitation care. Her research program focuses on three complementary objectives: 1) understanding and improving interactions between staff and residents in long-term care; 2) the supportive leadership capacity of staff in long-term care; and 3) interdisciplinary care delivery models for older adults with cognitive impairment that enhance the appropriateness and effectiveness of care. The results of this research program have led to innovations in models of care and positive outcomes for older adults

and staff in long-term care and rehabilitation environments that have been translated to protocols that guide the provision of care in these settings.
